



## Summary

- 1. Tenants-in-Common (TICs) is now about 9% of sales in the condo/TIC market.
- 2. Average selling price is approx. 7-13% less than a comparable condominium.
- 3. TICs comprise approx. 13% of all condo/TIC listings. Average listing price for 2 bedroom TICs is currently is 9-13% higher than the comparable condo. This is an anomaly since historically TICs sell for below a comparable condo.
- 4. While some controversy remains whenever TICs are mentioned, the data clearly shows that many buyers continue to decide that the price differential between condos and TICs make any potential risks worth taking in order to own a home and a piece of San Francisco.

#### Background

A unique segment of the San Francisco market is Tenancy-in-Common. It has developed as a market response to the strict condominium conversion lottery system which, until recently, permitted only 200 units (not buildings -- units) to win the lottery and begin the condo conversion process each year. Recent legislation has put a moratorium on all condo conversions except for 2-unit buildings for the next 10 years or so.

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
